



YEAR 11 2026 SUBJECT SELECTION

Dear Year 10 students, parents and carers,

Glenwood High School's curriculum structure is designed to align with student interests and aspirations while ensuring compliance with NESA requirements. Our Stage 6 subject selection process allows us to offer a diverse range of subjects tailored to the needs of our student body.

We follow a structured approach to support students in making informed decisions about their future studies. The first step involves collecting subject preferences, which helps us determine the subjects to offer and allocate resources effectively. It is crucial for both students and parents to understand the processes involved in successfully completing Stage 6 studies, including the importance of the student's skill development, interests, aspirations, and future study and career goals. Selecting subject preferences marks the beginning of this collaborative journey.

Several events are planned to ensure you and your child can make the most informed decisions about subject preferences for Year 11:

Term 2 Week 6

All Year 10 students engage in Work Experience.

Term 2 Weeks 7/8

Subject selection presentations and facilities tour for students by faculty staff during lesson times. Students will be able to ask questions about the variety of subjects on offer, and have exposure to some of the new and/or renovated facilities they may not have had the opportunity to experience yet; for example, our new commercial kitchens. They are also encouraged to speak with their class teachers and older students who are studying the Stage 6 curriculum for further advice. The Subject Selection booklet will also be published on our school website.

Term 2 Week 9, Tuesday 24 June

Parent Information Night for Year 10 into 11, commencing at 6pm in school hall.

Term 2, Week 9

An email will be sent to students containing the access code to enter subject preferences. Students must print a copy of their subject confirmation form once submitted, signed by both parent and student. This must be returned to the front office by Friday 1 August.

Term 2 Week 10

Year 10 Academic Reports are published for parents. Reports can be used to identify student strengths and areas for development, in order to inform their subject preferences.

Term 3 Week 2, Friday 1 August

Students subject preference survey closes. All confirmation forms should be submitted to front office by 3pm.

Term 3 Week 9, Friday 19 September

All students are required to attend a Career Pathways interview at school. The interview will also serve to ensure subject preferences align with student strengths, NESA requirements, and career aspirations. These interviews, conducted by the school executive team, are designed to facilitate student requests and ensure they have chosen the best possible options to suit their individual needs and future endeavors. During the interview, students will confirm their patterns of study and subject selections and will have the opportunity to make alterations to their subjects, pending availability. More information regarding the subject interviews will be provided closer to the date.


Late Term 4
