Pathways to Your Dream Degree

Applying for uni next year but worried that you won't meet the ATAR requirements for your dream degree? Most institutions offer pathway options for applicants who don't meet the standard entry criteria for their courses. Often, you'll be able to find a different avenue into the course you're aiming for.

If you don't get an offer into your chosen degree because you haven't met the required lowest selection rank, you could start an alternative undergraduate course with a lower entry rank. Once you've successfully completed the first year of that degree, and have results that will improve your selection rank, you can then apply again for the degree you really want. Bridging courses are open to everyone. You don't need to be commencing study at the University to register for a bridging course.

The bridging courses run in January/February and registration is now open.

If you do not have the assumed knowledge for your course, we strongly recommend that you undertake bridging studies. Otherwise, you might find it difficult to manage the work, as your lecturer will assume you are familiar with this area of study. Bridging courses are also useful if you struggled with the subject in high school, or need a refresher. Bridging courses do not provide you with enrolment qualifications or satisfy prerequisites for degrees within the University of Sydney

7 November

Theatre, above all, is a spatial artform. It's about defining the relationship and energy flow between audience and performer; it's putting ideas into space; it's finding a physical form to convey the emotional landscape of a play. In this webinar, we are delighted to host award-winning set and costume designer, Isabel Hudson, who will be in conversation with Dr Paul Dwyer from the Discipline of Theatre and Performance Studies. We'll look at a couple of Isabel's beautiful finished designs, analysing key steps in the process through which they were developed and how they support the overall vision of the play. Then we'll talk about perhaps the hardest part: how do you even begin? What should you be looking for on the first read of whatever play you select from the HSC Drama prescribed texts? How do you find those first few sparks of a concept/vision? How do you stretch and test your ideas with the goal of executing a design that's original, inventive, coherent and practical? While our focus is on set design, the underlying principles are, of course, also directly relevant to other HSC Drama Individual Projects in Design (e.g. costume and lighting) and Critical Analysis (e.g. director's folio and portfolio of theatre criticism).

The Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) is the minimum requirement to earn a living as a pilot in Australia. You'll start your training learning the fundamentals of flight in single engine aeroplanes such as the Piper Warrior, before progressing towards larger and more complex aircraft culminating in your CPL flight test being performed in the legendary Cessna 182T Skylane.
