## Term 2, Week 7 - Friday, 12 June 2020

Year 10 - Meningococcal ACWY Vaccine

(Catch-up) Year 7, 1st dose HPV & dTpa Vaccine

## Term 3, Week 8 - Friday, 11 September 2020

Year 7 – 2<sup>nd</sup> dose HPV Vaccine

(Catch-up) Year 10 – Meningococcal ACWY Vaccine

Please ensure that your child eats breakfast on the day of the school vaccination clinic.

Parents/guardians who wish to withdraw consent for any reason may do so by writing to the school Principal or phone the school. The Procedure for Withdrawal of Consent is available on the NSW Health website at www.health.nsw.gov.au/immunisation.

A Record of Vaccination will be provided to each student vaccinated at each clinic. You should ensure that this record is kept for future reference. Please do not assume that your child has been vaccinated if you do not receive this Record of Vaccination. Vaccination records will be uploaded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) to provide a complete immunisation history for your child.
