




CREATING MY ACCOUNT

Students will receive an email to activate their account. Follow the steps below to ensure you create your account correctly.


1. The email you receive from Turnitin will look like the image below. Click on the 'Create Your Password' button to begin setting up your account.



2. Clicking the link will take you to the Turnitin website. Enter your email and your last name. Your email **must be your student email**, which ends with @education.nsw.gov.au. Your last name must have capital letters as well, since the system is case sensitive.

3. Once you've filled in these details, you'll see this notice.

4. Your email should look the same as below. You need to click on the hyperlinked 'here' to continue setting up your account.
BE CAREFUL – This is only accessible for 24 hours once you've receiving the email, so be sure to finish the process.



5. You now need to make your password. Ensure it is something you will remember, and follows Turnitin's password expectations. Only you will have access to your password.

7. Fill in your student email and password, which you just created, to log into your account.




